5. Read Revelation 3:19. Can you remember a time that God showed you His love through His discipline? What happened?

6. Use one word to describe God's relationship with you. Why did you use that word?

Next Steps:

1. What can you do this week to be more hot in your relationship with Christ this week? What can you do to be refreshing to others this week?

2. Identify a spiritually lukewarm area of your life and ask God to help you ruthlessly eliminate it in your life.
